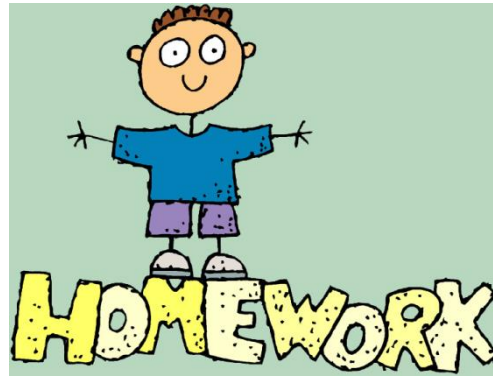
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# How we assess

To consolidate - little and often

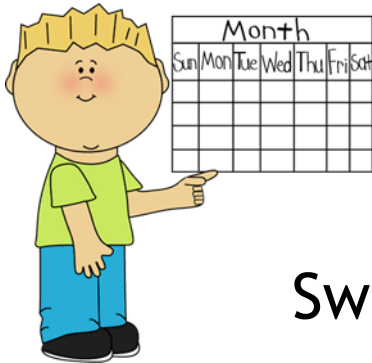
To help parents understand what the children are working on
