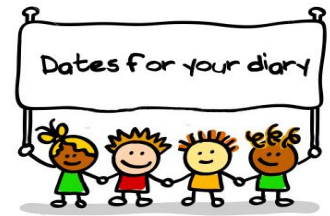


We look forward to hearing their plans for how we can improve our school further.

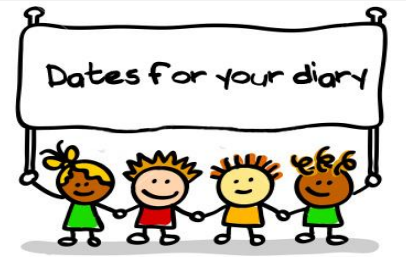
