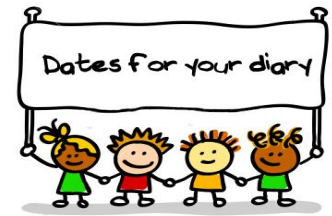
There will be no more 'Drop &.....' this term. We will announce days and times for Term 1 in September. Thank you for your attendance & support.
